



**Unit Title: Career Research Project** 

Grade Level: Grade 10
Subject Area: English

Duration/Length/Number of class periods: 5-week unit

#### Description:

Students research and write/present a career research paper on a career of interest to them. They will find X# of college/training programs and talk to an expert in the field to build their understanding of the career
