



Unit Title: New Hire PD/Google Classroom 101

Subject Area: Ed Tech Support/Tech Integration

Description:

Create a Google Classroom 1:1 Tutorial for new hires and standing staff, framed for an ACC employee. Example: create a standard Middle School Google Classroom but with a banner that identifies the course as math or science, and with common agreed upon ACC themes.

Collaborator

Educators dedicate time to collaborate with both colleagues and students to improve practice, discover and share resources and ideas, and solve problems. Educators:

Facilitator

- Complete the course essentials when setting up their first unit for the school year.
