What is College Possible?

College Possible Minnesota coaches low-income students to and through college. AmeriCorps members serve as guides to coach students on their path to college graduation.

College Possible helps students to:

- Find 'best fit' colleges and do campus visits
- Complete ACT/SAT registration and work on essay strategies
- Apply for college, coach on cost, scholarships and financial aid
- Practice professional communication and essay skills
- Prepare for the transition to college life

Quick Stats

- Over 20,000 students in Minnesota served since 2000
- 99% earned admission to college
- 26% is average ACT score improvement in Minnesota after 1 year in College Possible program

As a volunteer, know these students are:

- Attending after-school sessions once a month junior year or twice a week senior year
- Recruited to be a part of the program
- Typically the first in their family to go to college
- Four times more likely to earn a college degree than their lowincome peers
