Transition Plus helps students in:

To participate, students must:

- Be 18-21 years old
- Have completed their senior year of high school
- Have an Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- Have goals within the five areas of transition listed above

- Learning in a hands-on environment
- Undergoing extensive learning and training within the community they live
- Participating in Community-Based Instruction every Friday.
 Students visit various institutions in the community that meet the needs of adults with disabilities.
