## **Technology Tips**



Camera & Mic: Keep your video ON throughout the entire meeting. Mute your mic when you aren't speaking.



Location: Try to find a place with good lighting, a neutral background, and a stable internet connection. Avoid sitting in front of a window. If unavoidable, try to close the curtains. If possible, a quiet place is also a great idea!



Device: Use a device that has a front-facing camera and is fully charged. Keep the device in one place so it isn't moving around. Make sure your head and shoulders are in the frame and you are sitting up instead of laying down.



#### What should I wear?

Wear something you feel comfortable in that is school appropriate. Mentors don't care about what you wear; they are excited to meet YOU!



#### How do I stay focused?

When attending an event from home, it is easy to be distracted. Let the people around you know you will be at this event for one hour and minimize other distractions like your TV, other homework, and phone in order to participate fully.



### What will we talk about?

Mentors will might ask you questions like:

- Can you introduce yourself?
- How is school going?
- What are your strengths? What are you already really good at?

You can ask your mentor questions like:

- Can you tell me more about your job?
- How has work been going?

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
