FlipGrid Introductions

Students and mentors create “get to know me” videos using FlipGrid. Students and mentors will get to see each other and learn more about each other through icebreaker type questions. *(Ideal for asynchronous distance learning and AVID students.)*

Small Group Virtual Meet and Greet

Small groups of student-mentor pairs (6-10 people total) will meet using a virtual platform. They will play icebreaker games to get to know each other and talk about career paths and life after high school. Requires all students to be virtually present at a specific date/time. Teacher is required to moderate half of the meetings. Limit to classes of 30 students or less *(Ideal for synchronous distance learning and mature students.)*

Get to Know Me Slideshow

Students and mentors create “get to know me” slideshows using a template from BestPrep. Students and mentors will get to see pictures of each other as well as learn more about their favorite things, future goals, and hobbies/interests. (Ideal for asynchronous distance learning or in-person learning and AVID students.)

Social Styles

Students and mentors take a quiz to determine their social style using a worksheet from BestPrep. They write about their quiz results and how social styles play a role in school and the workplace. (Ideal for asynchronous distance learning or in-person learning and higher level classes.)

LIST C: Career Focused Activities

Career Scavenger Hunt

Students learn more about careers available at the company by completing an online scavenger hunt (using the company website and search engine). (Ideal for distance or in-person learning and higher level classes.)

Career Kahoot

Students compete in a Kahoot “self-paced challenge” by answering multiple choice questions about the company and careers available at the company. (Ideal for asynchronous distance learning and any level.)

3



Career Panel

Using an online platform, five employees at the company share their schooling and career. Requires all students to be virtually present at a specific date/time. (Ideal for synchronous distance learning and mature students.)

Career Profiles

Students watch short career videos created by employees at the company. The videos explain what the job entails and skills needed. (Ideal for asynchronous distance learning and any level.)
