Day-to-Day Lesson Plan

This is a one-day lesson for a PD session.

- Activity 1. Opening activity Answer Google Form relating to pain points teachers feel in the classroom.
- Activity 2. App Hunt Teachers will engage with the Padlet or research a new app that they feel helps them solve a pain point in their workflows.
- Activity 3. Student Data Safety I will present a short mini-lecture on the relevant laws governing student data safety and how they apply to our school.
- **Activity 4.** Teachers will evaluate their app to see if it is safe for student use.
- Activity 5. Teachers will create a plan to implement the app into their workflow. This plan will include testing, roll out and evaluation.
- Activity 6. App Review Teachers will go to the padlet to create a review on their app. This padlet will be available for other teachers to access as a resource for new apps.
