Sales Tax


 Sales tax is a tax, usually paid by the consumer at the point of purchase, for certain goods and services.



Payroll Tax

- These are taxes withheld from (taken out of) employees' pay by their employers.
 - Payroll taxes include Social Security and Medicare tax.
 - You do not get these taxes back at tax time.



Paycheck

- Social Security (FICA) tax rate is 6.2%
- Medicare tax is 1.45%

Employers are also required to pay the same amount as the employee.

Income Tax

- Income tax is also withheld by employers throughout the year.
 - Federal
 - State
















Federal Spending- 2015


Federal Outlays for - FY 2015

State Spending for Minnesota - FY 2015


