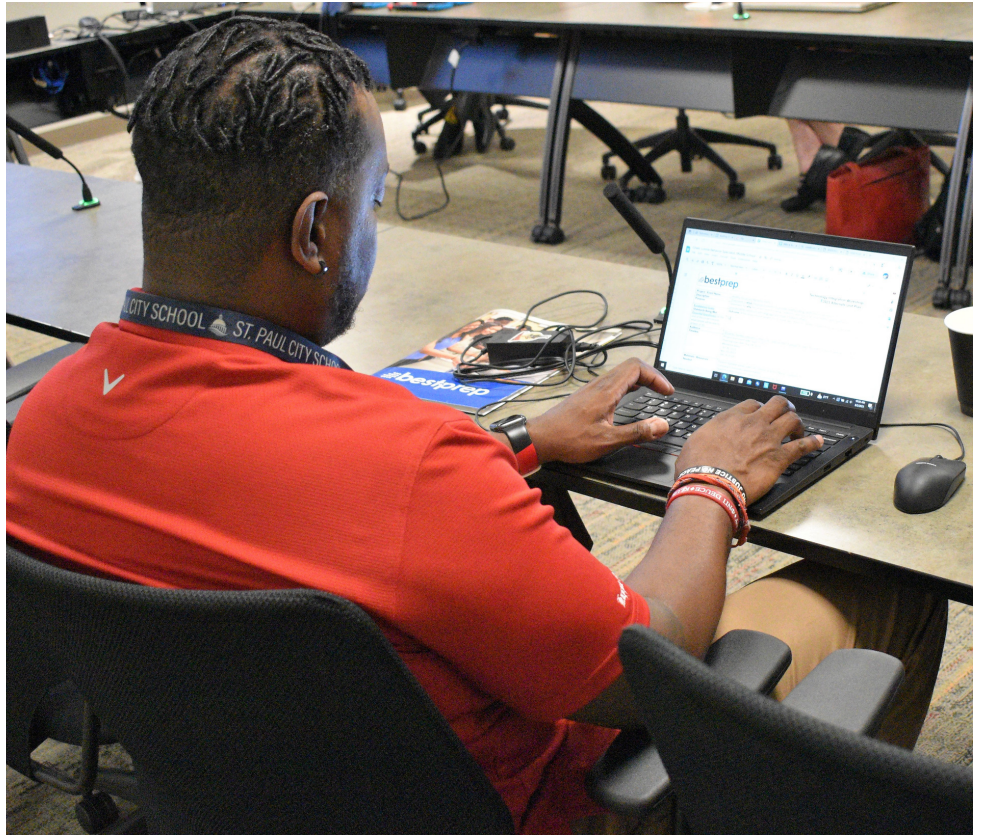

### PROGRAM RESULTS
