Open Email from eMentors

- You will receive a Welcome Email from BestPrep within a few days of the connection starting. This will have a link to view the eMentors portal where you can view the weekly writing prompts, see your student's messages and respond after they write. If you will be Out of the Office during this connection please see Step 5 below.
- Once your student writes you will receive an email from Mentoring@bestprep.org with the Subject: Weekly Student Prompt - BestPrep Mentoring

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Wait for next weeks message



- Keep in mind that there are many reasons a student may not message. Teachers and BestPrep staff check in on students that have not written. Students are also graded on their assignment.
- You will be able to send a message to your student about the weekly prompt, or a brief hello, 1 week after the prompt due date even if they have not written.

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Additional Connection Info and OOO feature

- In the upper right corner you will see an Info button and a Settings button. These have extra information about eMentors and this connection as well as a place to mark that you will be Out of Office so we know your message may be delayed.
