Established in 1976, BestPrep is a Minnesota-based nonprofit organization that prepares students to be career-focused and financially capable.

Our Programs

Classroom Plus inspires students to create a vision for the future through career exploration via classroom speakers, corporate career days, workplace tours, and mock interviews.

eMentors prepares students with the skills needed for success in school, career, and life through weekly email exchanges with volunteer business mentors.

Financial Matters motivates students to make sound money management decisions and become financially savvy via industry professionals delivering classroom presentations on personal finance topics.

The Stock Market Game™ (SMG) teaches students about economics, investing, and the importance of a long-term savings strategy. Student teams invest hypothetical money in stocks and mutual funds.

Minnesota Business Venture (MBV) ignites students' passion to achieve success and develop career aspirations for the future through a week-long business and career development camp held on a college campus. High school students work directly with business leaders to learn about career paths and gain personal finance skills.

Volunteer as an Individual

Classroom Presentations

Provide a 45-minute presentation on a career, workplace skill, or financial literacy topic.

Participate in Mock Interviews*

Provide mock interviews for students during the school year or at MBV.

Essay Judge

Judge student submissions based on a rubric.

Resident Business Leader

Mentor a group of students at MBV while spending a week living on a college campus.

Business Plan Judge

Spend a half-day with MBV students as they present their business plan to a panel.

Workplace Tour Guide

Provide students the opportunity to see your company come to life firsthand through an on-site tour.

Volunteer as a Group

eMentors

Employees from participating companies provide one-on-one online mentoring to a class of students for 8 weeks based on weekly guiding questions. Students visit your company once mid-way through the program.

Budgeting Simulations^

Help students learn budgeting skills in small groups. Volunteers host stations as students make decisions about daily expenditures.
