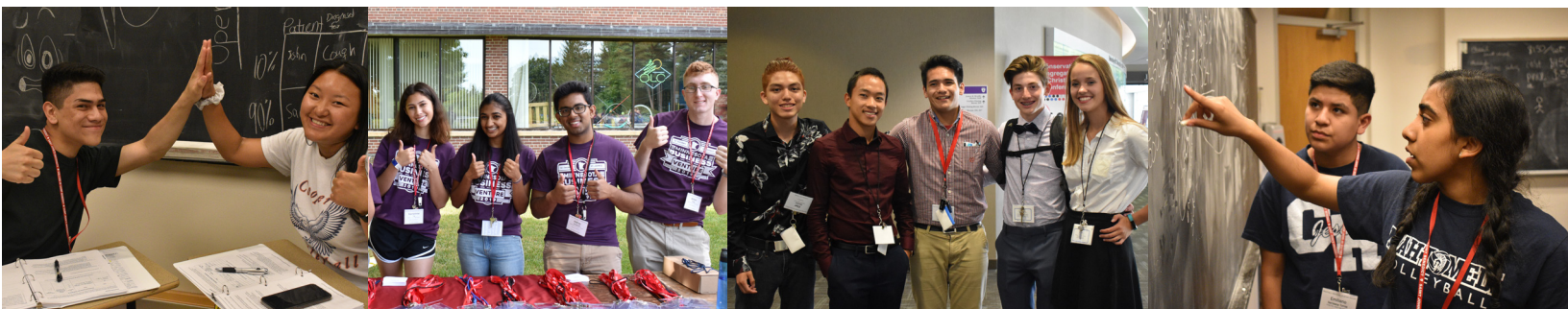

● How much?

Camp tuition is generously covered by donors who provide sponsorships for all participants that cover the \$1,300 cost per student. BestPrep secures these sponsorships for you. As a result, students only pay a registration fee: \$150 for applications received by Friday, April 24, 2020; or \$200 for applications received after that date. All costs are covered, including meals, college dorm housing, program materials and activities.

Financial assistance is available to students who provide free/reduced lunch documentation. Limited free bus transportation is available from Minneapolis and St. Paul for those who need a ride to MBV.

● How do I apply?

- Complete the attached application or go online to www.bestprep.org/mbvapp.
- Fill out the application, answer three questions (instructions on the back), obtain the required information from an educator and submit it to BestPrep with the payment.
- Agree to commit six days of your time at the camp with 100% willingness to learn and participate. You must also comply with all University and MBV policies.

● Who is BestPrep?

BestPrep is a nonprofit organization that offers seven programs, dedicated to inspiring Minnesota students to succeed in work and life: Classroom Plus, Cloud Coach, eMentors, Financial Matters, Minnesota Business Venture, The Stock Market Game™, and Technology Integration Workshop.

● What's next?

Once we review your application, you will be notified and sent medical and code of conduct forms that must be completed and returned by the given due date. **Check your email for the MBV confirmation.** If the student has a physical disability please call or email MBV by May 15 to determine the accommodations that can be made.
