About Classroom Plus

Classroom Plus focuses on educating students on business and career skills. Bridging the gap between lessons learned in the classroom and skills utilized in the workplace, this program brings speakers into classrooms and provides mock interviews, workplace tours, and more. Due to the pandemic, BestPrep adjusted its programming to virtual in spring 2020. Rather than presenting in the classroom, volunteer speakers recorded presentations which were then assigned to students to view.
